Therefore, Action Center allows you to suspend and resume the workflow, after human input is provided.

Notes: Specific user scenarios were tested to ensure critical user paths were included in the VPAT. All application content was not tested, but rather a crucial sampling of content was used for test cases. As the product is available in Automation Cloud, Automation Suite and as Standalone, the product User interface is common for all these types, so this VPAT is covering for all versions available.

Evaluation Methods Used: New Edition's Test Process for WCAG 2.1 AAA was used (based on Trusted Tester v5, WCAG 2.0 AAA, WCAG 2.1 A-AAA, and Section 508 Software testing). The following testing tools were used on a Windows 10 desktop: Accessibility Insights for Windows v1.1, ANDI, Text spacing bookmarklet, Color Contrast Analyzer, NVDA v2021, and external keyboard.

Testing was performed by certified Trusted Testers (v5) from New Editions Consulting, Inc.
