As the product is available in Automation Cloud, Automation Suite and as Standalone, the product User Interface is common for all these types, so this VPAT is covering for all versions available.

Evaluation Methods Used: New Edition’s Test Process for WCAG 2.1 AA was used (based on Trusted Tester v5, WCAG 2.1 A-AA, and Section 508 Web testing). The following testing tools were used on a Windows 10 desktop: Accessibility Insights for Windows v1.1, Color Contrast Analyzer, text spacing bookmarklet, NVDA v2021, external keyboard, and ANDI.

Testing was performed by certified Trusted Testers (v5) from New Editions Consulting, Inc.
