Notes: Specific user scenarios were tested to ensure critical user paths were included in the VPAT. All application content was not tested, but rather a crucial sampling of content was used for test cases.

Evaluation Methods Used: Software Test Process for WCAG 2.2 AA was used (based on Trusted Tester v5, WCAG 2.0 AA, WCAG 2.1 A-AA, WCAG 2.2 and Section 508 Software testing).

The following testing tools were used on a Windows 10 desktop and Chrome Browser: Accessibility Insights for Windows v1.1, Color Contrast Analyzer, NVDA v2024.1, Axe® accessibility testing tools: axe Auditor and the axe DEvTools browser extension and external keyboard.

Testing was performed by Certified Professional in Accessibility Core Competencies from Deque and by certified Trusted Testers (v5) from New Editions Consulting, Inc.

The radio buttons are not associated with the checkbox, such as "Enforce Analyzer before Publish", so a user may not understand the purpose of the radio button. Accessible names must provide the full purpose and meaning of the element. Radio buttons are not associated with their instructions; instead they just say yes or no. The radio button's accessible name/description should also communicate "Allow users to send feedback, required", for example.

Elements must only use supported ARIA attributes to the 'help(?)' button in the 'Edit existing Al Trust Layer Policy' screen. The "Solution management screen" step is missing the aria-current="step" attribute. There is no instruction or programmatic description for keyboard users to resize columns.
